Re: Postponement of GCS Summit Singapore - 23 - 26 March 2020

To Whom it may concern,

In light of the serious nature of the coronavirus health crisis, we regret to inform you that we have no choice but to postpone the 2020 Summit which was due to take place 23 – 26 March 2020.

We have been monitoring the situation and have been in communication with our Singapore colleagues. Without a doubt this is an emerging health crisis which has significantly affected China and other countries in the region such as our host country Singapore. Over the weekend Singapore upgraded their coronavirus alert level to Orange. This guidance from the government required our host campus, the National University of Singapore, to impose strict health guidelines, including cancelling all campus events with 50 or more attendees until further notice.

In addition, the joint one-day conference with the South East Asia Association of Graduate Employers (SEAAGE) is being postponed. Once we identify a new date for the Global Summit, the SEAAGE organisers will plan their event to coincide with ours so that you can attend both the Summit and SEAAGE as was originally planned.

The GCS Summit will be rescheduled to a later date in 2020 which will be decided in the coming weeks.
